Pale yellow

Youthful nose

Straw, Banana on the nose and palette & stone fruits, hint of asparagus . Great acid,well balanced. Great length

Mann Methode Champenoise 05

Salmon with clear hues.

Finely crafted great local wine. Understated & youthful perfumed nose. Beautiful intergration only complaint is that it's a bit short. Good tight acid. Melon and apple on the palette.

Coldstream Hills Pinot Noir 05

Although it is undoubtedly a finely crafted wine. I've never truly been a fan because of my personal love for the barnyardy, fungal pinots. Pale red with violet hues. Raspberries and strawberries. Hints of earth but still clean, smokey. Soft acid but lacking

De Bortolli Noble One 05

These guys just cant go wrong. If you haven't tried a sticky before this is the one to get you into them. Floral & a touch of musk on the nose. Not as much apricot and residual sugar as other years but still present. Silky texture with great weight.

Seresin Sauv Blanc 05

The most recent addition to the Dear Friends wine list. And well worth inclusion. If you're looking for something with a bit more oomf than your usual NZ flair than this is for you. Pale yellow in appearance. Sharp crisp acid, candied apples on the palette, without the sickly sweetness. Good balance, great all round wine. Superb mouthfeel.

Winelist

Features a good mix of local, WA and international. Including a number of wines you will struggle to find elsewhere. If you want to splash out theres vintage Champagne. Features some interesting spirits, such as Calvados (Apple Brandy) which I was pleasantly surprised to see that they warm up and the new wild swan vodka range. If your after a ballsy wine then they have some aged shiraz, also of note if you like your wines big check out the Holy Trinity GSM.
